

January Cave Trip

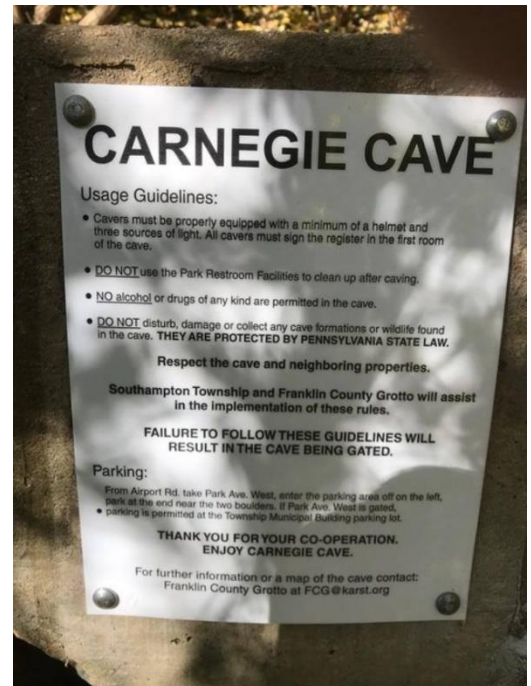
Saturday January 22nd - Carnegie Cave

The January trip will be held in Shippensburg Pennsylvania. The cave is 2-hours from DC, so it is a convenient day trip.

The Carnegie Cave is unique because is located underneath I-81. Yes, it is under a four-lane highway! When the highway was built in the 1970's, construction workers added a corrugated pipe from the entrance to the side of the road - it's a rather long pipe. Like most caves there is walking and crawling passage. Unlike most caves is the long belly slide.

Cavers should know

- The cave is 1,680 feet long so you will see every inch.
- The cave has two areas with standing water (Knee deep). A little water, a lot of clay, equals tons of mud.
- Parking is 1/10 of a mile from the cave.
- The cave is in a township park. Cavers must be respectful and remain clothed in the parking lot.
- Cavers cannot use the bathroom facilities at the park to change or clean up.
- I would suggest bringing clean clothing to the cave entrance. After the trip, change in the wooded area near the entrance
